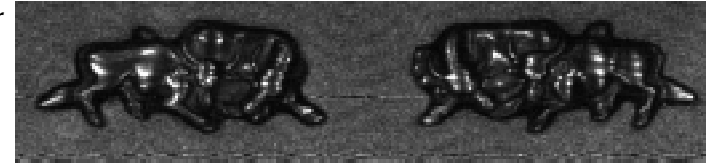

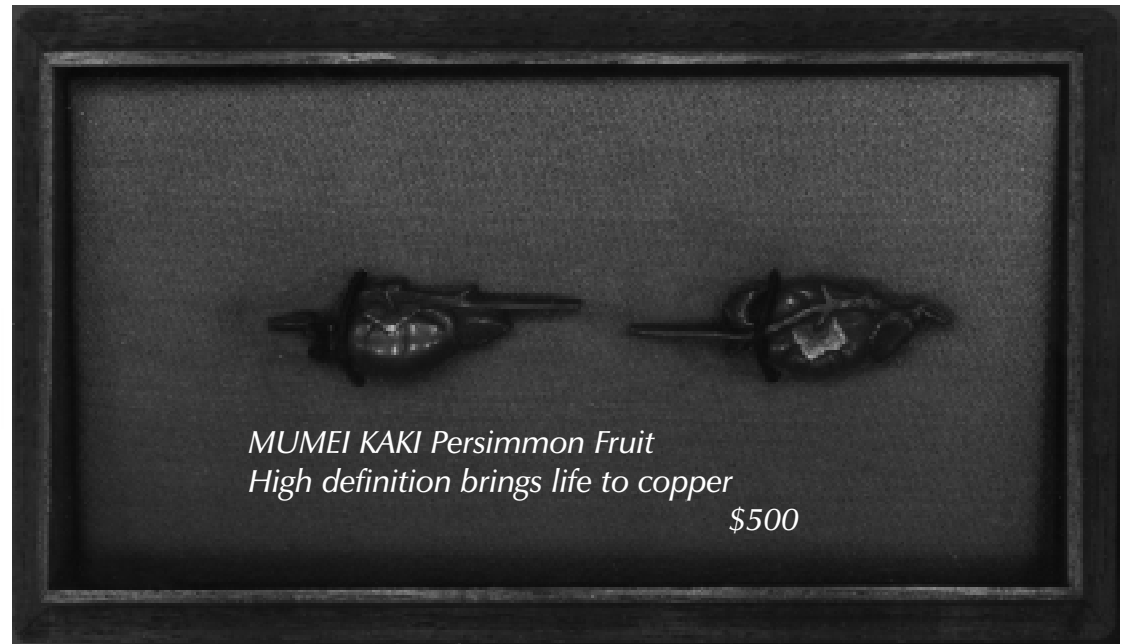
Dragon and Clouds
